**CORAL GABLES, Fla. – May 19, 2023** – Actors' Playhouse at the Miracle Theatre is thrilled to continue its milestone 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary season with **David Auburn's** *Proof* playing now through June 4, 2023. His short plays have been collected in the volume *Fifth Planet and Other Plays* (DPS). His work has been published in Harper's, New England Review, and Guilt and Pleasure; and he was a contributing editor to the Oxford American Writers Thesaurus. A former Guggenheim Fellow, he lives in New York City.

**DAVID ARISCO (Artistic Director/Director)** has been Artistic Director of Actors' Playhouse for 35 years, 27 at the Miracle Theatre. His diverse career spans over 45 years as director, actor,

musical director, stage manager, symphonic conductor, and instrumentalist.
